How do you feel about the classism and equality portrayed in the Old London society?

How could you see magic helping or hindering your life?

What do you think is the hardest part of living with an invisible illness?

Do you think Yannia's medical condition is represented in an effective way?

Who is your favourite character, and why?

There is a very human element in the non-human characters. How did you react to this?

Did you identify with any of the characters? Why?
